In accordance with Oregon Administrative Rule 581-22-220, Eagle Point School District 9 performs yearly vision screenings for grades Kindergarten, 1st, 3rd, and 5th. Vision impairments in children are common and uncorrected vision problems can impair child development, interfere with early literacy and learning, lead to behavior problems in the classroom, and lead to permanent vision loss. Early detection and treatment are critical. Additionally, visual functioning is a strong predictor of academic performance in school-age children and vision disorders of childhood may continue to affect health and well-being throughout adulthood.
