QUALIFICATIONS:


- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Maintain a valid Oregon Driver's license with CDL (and/or any other required endorsements) and personal transportation.
- Must meet all state requirements for Bus Drivers.
- Knowledge of provision of Oregon Department of Motor Vehicles, Department of Education laws and district policies applicable to operation of vehicles transporting students.
- Minimum three years' experience driving a school bus.
- Training and experience in record keeping, computer experience desirable.
- Ability to work with team members, students and staff.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Ensure that all state transportation guidelines are followed.
- Maintain satisfactory attendance and punctuality.
- Ability to work cooperatively with staff, students and the public.
- Appropriately operate all vehicles and equipment.
- React to change productively and handle other tasks as assigned.
- Support the philosophy and mission of School District 9.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Requires prolonged sitting and standing.
- Must work in noisy, crowded and stressful environments.
- Requires stooping, bending, reaching, kneeling, climbing and balancing.
- May require physical exertion to manually move, lift, carry, pull or push heavy objects or materials.
- Requires ability to carry or drag a 125 lb. person, 30 feet in 30 seconds or less.
- Requires driving skills, including ability to operate a vehicle at night.
- May require lengthy and overnight travel.
- Must work indoors and outdoors year-round.



GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- Abide by all state school transportation regulations.
- Teach drivers how to provide safe and orderly transportation to and from school and school related activities.
- Develop and maintain assigned training schedule.
- Respect confidential information.
- Evaluate and provide input involving the abilities of drivers to provide safe and orderly transportation.
- Maintain accurate training records.
- See that district policies are observed at all times.
- Keep abreast of new information, innovative ideas and techniques.
- Other duties as assigned by the Transportation Supervisor.
